

Trout, Serenity, and the Beauty of the Outdoors...

There is no other place quite like this in the state of Vermont. And when it comes to trout fishing and the pleasures of the outdoors, there are very few places like this anywhere in New England.

Located in one corner of more than 600 acres of beautiful woodlands, the Meccawe Club is a spot where you can truly escape from all that goes on elsewhere.

■ Fish...relax on the screened-in porch and enjoy the view...hike old logging roads to the Coolidge State Forest. Or simply sit and read in front of a crackling fire in the fireplace.

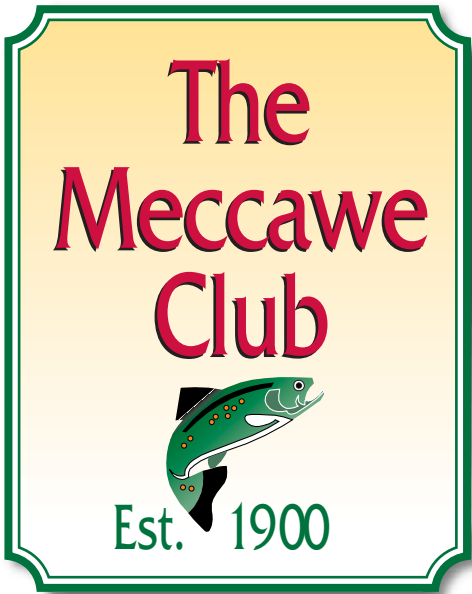
■ Membership is kept small —to roughly 60 people. Meccawe is a family-oriented club where you prepare your own meals and know that you have the privilege of being at a unique place where others have come to relax for several generations.

■ In the historic clubhouse is a large kitchen with two gas stoves, and a pantry with all the utensils required for any meal. The dining room will seat up to 10 comfortably, but you may prefer to eat on the

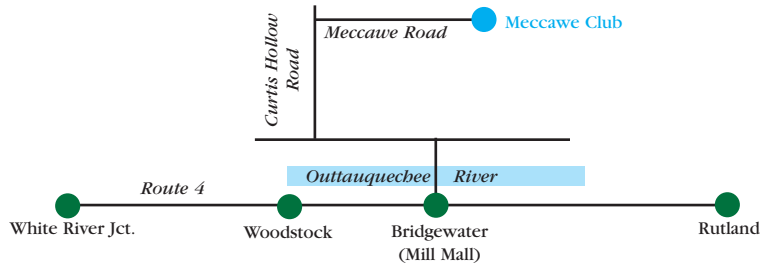
south-facing screened-in porch overlooking the 11-acre pond. Downstairs there is a spacious living room with sofas and chairs. Upstairs are six bedrooms with 2 or 3 beds each, and a bathroom with shower. There are also two outdoor bathrooms with running water. Electricity comes from a diesel generator, and there is plenty of firewood for the stoves and fireplace.

■ Fishing can be done from the shore or any of several rowboats. The season runs from early May through the end of October. The pond is stocked each spring with rainbow and brook trout up to 24". While we encourage fly fishing and catch-and-release, fishing is permitted with lures, spinners and worms. No live bait is allowed in the pond. You may keep fish, subject to the daily and season creel limit. A full-time caretaker resides at the club in season.





The Meccawe Club is located in Reading, Vermont, off U.S. Route 4, from the town of Bridgewater. It is about a 45 minute drive from both White River and Rutland. Go up Curtis Hollow Road (in back of the Bridgewater Mill Mall), turn right on Meccawe Road, and follow it to the end.



Membership applications are available from any current member. Once you become a member, there are a number of opportunities each year to help out with activities and volunteer work details. We look forward to your visit.
